

GRD Electronic Operation with Electric Timer Actuated Valve

Green light on—shows power in on. Valve is closed. Pre-set time in control box will activate to open valve at night to drain off grease build-up.

Red light on—valve is closed.

Orange light on—cleaning cycle has been activated and drain valve has been opened. Empty collector box of grease into recycling barrel.

Larger red “stop” button on side below lights is for closing of the valve during cleaning cycle. This should only be used if the grease draining out needs to be stopped to empty the collector box if it is going to overflow.

The valve can be opened manually large red button on the bottom of the control box. When released valve will close. By allowing the valve to open and then return to closed position and GRD can be manually operated to see what product comes out of the drain off valve (grease or water). If too much grease is building up the timer in the control box can be set with additional events to activate the valve at night on other days of the week.

Bottom red light has circuit breaker for heater. Red light on means call for service of heating element if it will not reset.
